December 2006 Business Meeting

The regular meeting of the West Earl Fire Company was brought to order on December 5th 2006 at 7:02 PM by President Barry Gehman. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as read. The treasurer's report was approved as shown on the attached copy.

MEMBERSHIP:

Paul Frymyer was accepted as a Firefighter. Dale Ebersole and Tom Bashore were accepted on a 90 day probation as associate members. This gives us 65 members with 5 on probation.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Nolt reported 13 calls for November and 3 so far for December giving us 258 for the year. A letter was received from the Southern Lancaster County Inter Municipal Council thanking our Fire Police for their assistance at the Bart Township Incident in October. The two juveniles that needed community service have been here several nights and they'll be finishing up in January. Upcoming training was discussed including the VRT class that will start here in January.

ZONE & COUNTY:

The next Zone meeting is December 11th at Station 3-9.

FIRE POLICE:

\$1,650 in donations were received bringing our total donations for the year to \$4,250. We assisted with 32 special events this year which included 21 in West Earl Township, 6 in Manheim Township, 2 in Akron Boro, 1 in Lititz Boro, 1 in New Holland Boro and 1 in Bart Township, for a total of 655 hours. Appointed officers for 2007 are Lieutenant Bob Lamb and Sgt. Bill Shaw.

OLD BUSINESS:

Deputy Chief Stoltzfus reported the defective air pack off the Engine was repaired and is back in service. The blood drive that was held here in November collected 28 pints of blood which was very good for the first time. Captain Van Marter reported he will be getting approximately 19,000 feet of molding from Prevo for our sale. Bob Lamb reported he is checking with a gentleman from Middletown on the possibility of getting some cots.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bob Lamb reported he contacted the Township for an updated address list. He is currently working on getting a new list together for our 2007 mailings. The Santa Claus tour will be held on December 23rd.
